This building was constructed through the Low-Income Affordable Marketplace Program (LAMP) of the New York City Housing Development Corporation, the Low Income Rental Program (LIRP) and The Inclusionary Housing Program of The New York City Housing Preservation and Development. Individuals or households who meet the income and household size requirements listed in the table below may apply. Qualified applicants will be required to meet additional selection criteria such as asset limits.

What Happens After you Submit an Application?

Applications will be processed sequentially in order based upon date/time of receipt of application. If you appear to qualify, you will be contacted to continue the process of determining your eligibility. You will be asked to submit documents that verify your household size, identity of members of your household, and your household income.
